

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT NO PARKING WITHIN 100 FEET OF AND WITHIN THE TURNAROUND ON ALL CUL DE SACS IN CARLISLE TOWNSHIP, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, Carlisle Township Board of Trustees, Lorain County, Ohio has determined the public safety and welfare would be served by the establishment of a parking ban on all Cul de Sacs in the township, and

Whereas, the regulations would not conflict with the uniform traffic act, and are applicable only to the unincorporated areas of Carlisle Township; and

Whereas, Section 505.17 of the Ohio Revised Code enables a township board of trustees to adopt parking regulations;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Carlisle Township Board of Trustees:

I. Pursuant to R.C. 505.17(A) and (B)(1) the following parking regulations are hereby established within the unincorporated areas of Carlisle Township;

Parking shall be prohibited 100 feet from and within the turnaround on all Cul de Sacs.

II. The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to post the regulations in five conspicuous places in the township for thirty days and cause the same to be published for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the township.

III. The regulations shall become effective upon the completion of the posting and the newspaper publication, and upon posting of signs giving notice of the regulations in accordance with standards of the Ohio Department of Transportation.

IV. Pursuant to R.C. 505.17(D), the Board of Trustees may order into storage any vehicle parked in violation of these regulations. The owner or any lien holder of a vehicle ordered into storage may claim the vehicle upon presentation of proof of ownership, which may be evidenced by a certificate of title, and payment of all expenses, charges and fines incurred as a result of the parking violation and removal and storage of the vehicle.

V. Pursuant to R.C. 505.17(E) whoever violates these regulations is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. Fines levied and collected under these regulations shall be paid into the Township general fund.

VI. These regulations are subject to the limitation, restrictions, and exceptions in section 4511.01 to 4511.76 and 4513.02 to 4513.37 of the Revised Code.
