RESOLUTION 99-04

A RESOLUTION FOR DRAINAGE AND CULVERTS INSTALLED IN THE RIGHT OF WAYS IN CARLISLE TOWNSHIP.

The Board of Trustees of Carlisle Township, Lorain County, Ohio hereby set the following rules and regulations for drainage systems and driveway culverts installed in the right of ways on Carlisle Township roads.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT

SECTION I. Right of Way Drainage Systems.

Only drainage systems designed to drain the road and road right of way, and approved by the Township will be permitted in Carlisle Township road right of ways.

There shall not be any private pipes or tiles in the right of way, except pipes or tiles draining to the road right of way that have been approved by the Township.

SECTION II. Driveway Culverts.

All driveway culverts in Township right of ways shall be of the type and size specified by the Township. The property owner must obtain the specified pipe and the Township may install it, or specify the proper grade and location of the pipe.

Twelve inch (12") inside diameter is the standard pipe size, but the Township may specify larger or smaller pipes, depending on the existing or future condition of drainage in the area.

SECTION III. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV. That this Resolution shall be in effect upon signing as provided by law.
